A successful school justice partnership requires a diverse group of stakeholders representing a variety of court, school, and community partners. Wherever possible, the partnership should also include stakeholders who represent the race, ethnicity, gender, sexual identity/expression and geographic diversity of the children in the community most impacted by the discipline and juvenile justice systems.
