Just a few moments ago, the Georgia House of Representatives passed HB 641, the Child Protection and Public Safety Act, 172-0! The bill is a comprehensive revision of Georgia's children's code.

As a founding member of the [JUST Georgia](#) coalition, Georgia Applesseed has supported and advocated for the passage of this critical legislation. The bill's success in the House is a huge step forward in the coalition's efforts to ensure access to justice for Georgia children and families.



Our attention now turns to the state Senate, as the legislation is currently pending in the Senate Rules Committee - the bill's last stop before a floor vote in the Senate.
